Several key persons and institutions have provided their whole hearted support in the planning, establishing and implementation of the PBSR, data abstraction and processing, data analysis and preparation of reports.

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
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

We are thankful to the scientific, technical, project and administrative staff at ICMR-NCDIR for their active involvement and commitment for the implementation of the registry and report preparation.


